Health Services

To protect the health of all students, there will be some changes to the operations of our School's Nurses' offices due to the Covid19 pandemic. Our goal is to provide a safe and healthy environment for all students and to prevent the transmission of illnesses. Please contact your school nurse with any questions or concerns.

Stay Home When You Are Sick

Check your child's temperature every morning. If 100 or higher, they must stay home until fever free for 24 hours without the use of medications. Students who are ill are to stay home. Contact your healthcare provider or the RCHD for additional guidance.



Limit of Nurse Office Visits

To prevent healthy students from coming in contact with sick students, only one student will be allowed in the nurse's office at a time. We will accommodate the needs of healthy students from outside the nurse's office when possible.



CDC Recommendations for Prevention of Illness

Washing hands frequently, wearing cloth face masks, and maintaining social distances of at least 3-6ft will be encouraged per Center of Disease Control recommendations.



Avoid Over-the-Counter Medications

Over-the-counter medications will be discouraged this school year. We do not want to mask the symptoms of illness or fevers by administering OTC medications at school. Cough drops will not be allowed.



Spartan Clinic will Continue

The Spartan Clinic will continue to be available to students. Updated paperwork is available on the district [website](#). The Spartan Clinic is an optional service provided to students.



Update Immunizations

Up to date immunizations are [required](#) to enroll for school. Please provide an updated immunization record to your students school nurse before the first day of school. Students enrolled in virtual learning must have updated immunizations on file.



Update Asthma Action Plan

The CDC is recommending the use of asthma inhalers *with spacers* for asthma management. Speak to your child's health care provider to obtain the proper equipment & to update their [Asthma Action Plan](#).



Students with Chronic Conditions

Parents of students with Chronic Health Conditions should provide [updated paperwork](#) to the school nurse before the first day of school. Please notify your school nurse of any health concerns.



Verify or Update Emergency Contacts

If your child presents with COVID-like symptoms, they will be placed in an isolation room and will need to be picked up immediately. Please ensure a contact can be reached at any given time.
