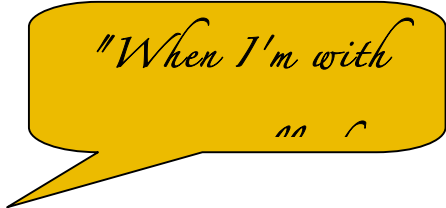

"The Big Brothers Big Sisters Mission is to help children reach their potential through professionally supported, one-to-one relationship with measurable impact."

Big Brothers Big Sisters research has shown that after 18 months of spending time with their Bigs through either school or community based mentoring, the Little Brothers and Little Sisters were:

- 46% less likely to begin using illegal drugs and 27% less likely to begin using alcohol
- 52% less likely to skip school and 37% less likely to skip a class
- More confident of their performance in schoolwork
- One-third less likely to hit someone
- And getting along better with their families



A Note from Francine Nichols

Moberly Public School District Elementary Resource Coordinator and Big Brothers Big Sisters Mentor Coordinator

Since implementing the Big Brothers Big Sisters program just over 4 years ago, over 40 children have been serviced by mentors. We currently have 15 stable matches with an increasing waiting list of children needing matches. I've been working in the social services field for over 20 years and I have never seen a program that serves kids and meets their on-going needs as well as Big Brothers Big Sisters. The school district has seen a decrease in truancy and disciplinary referrals, and an increase in grades, attitudes, and relationships with others. BBBS is a program that provides so much to both sides of the match. Bigs often tell us that they signed up to "do something for the kids," but end up with a relationship that changes them. Your involvement in Bowl for Kids' Sake is a vital part of our program sustainability expansion. On behalf of the Moberly Area Matches, thank you for your time and your participation!
